



Swimarathon 2017 Primary School Design Competition

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The competition is only open to Jersey primary school pupils, excluding family members of the Lions Club of Jersey, employees of RBC Wealth Management or anyone associated with the competition. One entry per pupil.
- 2. The design must fit 180mm x 180mm.
- 3. The completed competition slip should be submitted with each entry. Additional entry slips are available to download from www.lionsswimarathon.org.
- 4. By entering, participants agree that entries can be shared on the Lions Swimarathon Jersey Facebook page.
- 5. The closing date for entries is Friday 24th February 2017 and the designs should be sent to Lion Peter Tabb, 10 La Colline, Queen's Road, St Helier JE2 3XW or can be collected from the school by telephoning Lion Peter Tabb 726704. Entries will not be returned.
- 6. The judges are Lions Club of Jersey President, Andrew Quinn, Studio Manager at the JEP and RBC Wealth Management's mascot, Leo the Lion. The judges will select five winning designs which will be printed in the JEP before the event. Each design will feature on the front cover of one of the five Swimarathon daily bulletins. The judges' decision is final.
- 7. Each school submitting a winning design will be awarded a donation of £250 from the Lions Club of Jersey for the school itself or for a local charity of the school's choice. Only one prize will be offered per school. Each winning pupil will also receive a prize of art materials. The individual prize is non-transferable and there is no cash alternative.
- 8. The winners will be notified early March and their parent/guardian and a school representative will be invited to the prize presentation at the launch of the Swimarathon on Wednesday 8th March 2017 at 9am. The winners will be asked to take part in Swimarathon publicity.
- 9. Photographic or video images recorded at the Swimarathon by the Lions Club of Jersey or their agents may be used for future promotion of the Swimarathon or to promote the Royal Bank of Canada's community sponsorships. These images may be used in print or online.
