This year we're going great lengths for Jersey's youth in supporting five local charities that help young people. We are therefore looking for designs that illustrate 'the best thing about being a child'.

The five winning entries will be published in the JEP prior to the Swimarathon event. Each of the five winners will be awarded £250 for his or her school and an individual prize of art materials.

Some useful hints:

- 1. Designs should be bright and colourful illustrating 'the best thing about being a child';
- 2. The Swimarathon is a five day swimming event involving many of the Island's school children;
- 3. RBC Wealth Management is the long term sponsor of the Swimarathon;
- 4. The Swimarathon takes place at Les Quennevais Sports Centre from Wednesday 8th Sunday 12th March 2017;
- 5. The Swimarathon mascot is Leo the Lion.

Competition deadline: 24th February 2017

The rules are simple:

- 1. The design must fit 180mm x 180mm;
- The competition is open to all Jersey primary school pupils one entry per pupil, excluding family members of the Lions Club of Jersey and RBC Wealth Management;
- 3. The winners, with their parent/guardian and a school representative will be invited to the prize presentation at the launch of the Swimarathon on Wednesday 8th March 2017 and will be asked to take part in Swimarathon publicity.
